Dear Parent,

The Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES) has mandated compulsory assessments at the Cycle 3, Year 2 (grade 6) level in English Language Arts and Mathematics. These assessments are scheduled by the MEES to take place in May and June 2019. Please consult the schedule at your child's school for specific dates. The results of these assessments will be worth 20% of the students' final result for the year.

If the student has a valid excuse for missing a compulsory assessment, the final mark will be calculated based on the weighted results for the three terms.

The following are considered valid excuses for absences from a compulsory assessment (proof must be provided):

- Serious illness or accident confirmed by a medical report or certificate.
- Death of a close relative.
- Court summons.
- Participation in an important event, for which the coordinator for the certification of studies in general education in the youth sector of the Direction de la sanction des études has given its approval beforehand.

Students who are absent from a compulsory assessment without a valid excuse (listed above) are considered absent and will result in a grade of zero for the assessment.
